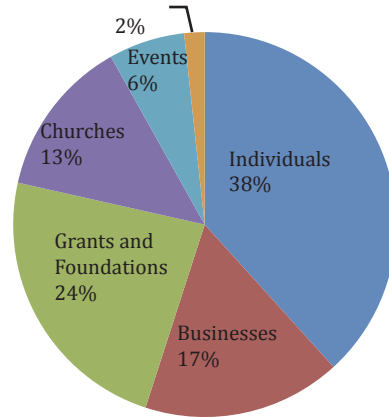
HFHC only exists through the generosity of volunteers who wisely see the link between individuals' health and the health of the community.

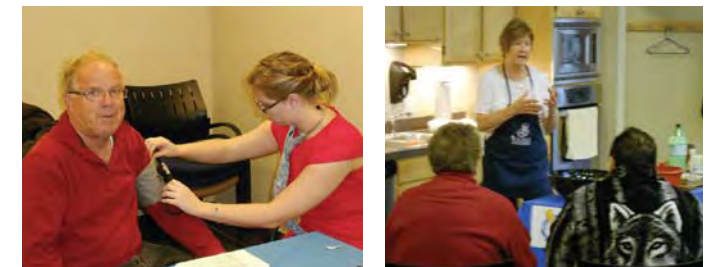
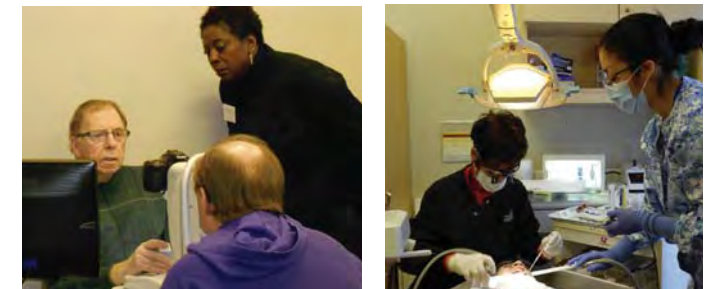
